
These SE courses have a registration period. That is, from Mo 24.02.2025 09:00 to We 26.02.2025 18:00. A deregistration is possible until We 26.02.2025 18:00.

The time of your registration within the registration period has no effect on the allocation of places - that means to say, there is no "first come, first served".


The following screenshots show the process of registering for a VO course. For registering for the other types of courses you may proceed in the same manner, however you will have to allocate points/preferences. Note that in this program all students will be let into the UE and SE courses, when registered. Therefore, your registration for such courses will not be hindered, even if the amount of points allocated for this purpose is quite low. This means that a lack of points for a specific course will not lead to not being registered for the same;)

Click on "Register" to complete the registration. As soon as the registration period has ended, the system will allocate the places on the courses and the status of your registration will be updated in **u:space** and you will receive an information e-mail on your u:account email address.


Step 1: Go to <a href="https://ufind.univie.ac.at/en/index.html">https://ufind.univie.ac.at/en/index.html</a> and click on Course Directory.



**Step 2:** Find your Masters' Program under **Directorate of Studies 22-Journalism and Communication Studies**: **Master Communication Science (550)**.



**Step 3:** Click on each of the SS2025 courses you wish to register for, as mentioned also on the first page of this guide.



**Step 4:** Click on Register/Deregister for this course.





To explain now more closely, how the research seminar registration works, let us have a look at each one of these SE Research Projects found in **u:find**.

If you click on 220057 SE Research Project A, you will find two options...



That is, Group 1 and Group 2 taught by Folker Hanusch and Katherine Sarikakis respectively.

Now, if you click on 220058 SE Research Project B, you will find only one option taught by Sofie Vranken.

Remember — your final choice must definitely consist of the 2 research seminars, which align best with your academic interests!

In addition, for each of the research seminars you choose, you will be asked to ascribe them to the proper module.

According to the curriculum of your studies, the **final module structure** should look as follows:

SE Research Project A, Teil 1, 10 ECTS, 2 SSt (pi)

SE Research Project B, Teil 1, 10 ECTS, 2 SSt (pi)

This means, that the one seminar you chose needs to be registered as "SE Research Project A, Part 1" and the other as "SE Research Project B, Part 1".
